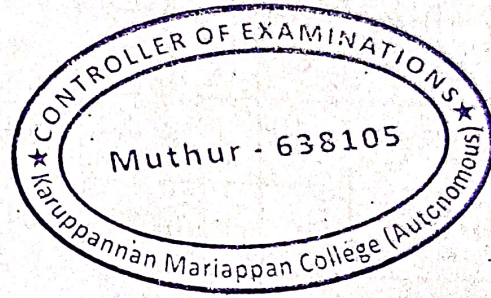
Programme Outcomes (POs)
